**Parental Release Form**

1. The parent or guardian of the student must request permission from the Assistant Principal for Instruction for student to leave campus to attend religious instruction. Completion of this form is sufficient for that request.
2. Your child will receive elective credit. First semester is *Stories from the Old Testament* and second semester is *#LiveFully - a Christian Worldview*.
3. The religious instruction should last no longer than one class period but no less than 50 minutes. The class will be held during 1st period.
4. If a student chooses off campus religious education for one period, the student makes the choice for the entire semester.
5. Norcross High School and Norcross Christian Learning Center are not responsible for transportation to and from the religious education course. Parents are responsible for making sure students have transportation to Mt Carmel United Methodist Church (5100 S Old Peachtree Rd) for the 1st period class. Students may drive and/or ride with another student with parent approval.

6. Students must enter NHS through the front lobby each day to sign in at the receptionist's desk.
